

Quarter 2 Narrative Writing Project: The Lessons We Learn

For the next few days, you will embark upon a writing project where you will use the writing process to write a narrative about the following prompt:

Think about a time in your life when you learned a valuable lesson. Write about your experience in story form with a plot, theme, and figurative language to convey a message to your audience.

Your story must be a minimum of 3 pages in length. You will have class time in the computer lab to type your paper.
